Motion for Removal for Cause Pursuant to WCRP Bylaws Article II, Section 8.

We, the undersigned, are requesting the removal of Sean Raesemann from the County Executive Committee of the Williamson County Republican Party for and without cause for the following reasons:

Mr. Raesemann has continually circumvented the Party Chair and the CEC to achieve his own objectives and has violated the bylaws of the Williamson County Republican Party and the Tennessee GOP:

1. Formed a vetting committee and held meetings without informing or including the Party Chair prior to the 2021 election year. Mr. Raesemann refused to work with the Chairman in forming additional vetting committees. With the exception of one individual, the list of people he was considering for a vetting committee were not members of the WCRP. Furthermore, the one WCRP member on Mr. Raesemann's list had an open lawsuit against Republican Governor, Bill Lee. (Article 5, Section 2)
2. During the Special Board Meeting, held by Zoom, on November 22, 2021, the Chairman informed the Board "the State Party Chairman Scott Golden said he does not approve the WCRP creating a vetting committee." At that time, the only requirement was to verify bona-fide status as a courtesy. Yet, Mr. Raesemann continued to vet candidates outside of the WCRP guidelines to solely benefit another PAC who actively works to undermine the county Republican Party.
3. Mr. Raesemann has repeatedly challenged the Chairman's authority, including by not limited to the following: while telling candidates that she is the problem with the GOP and savagely sending an email that indicate that she is not following bylaws which included stating that the WCRP Chairman has set up a nebulous "verification committee."
4. Mr. Raesemann recruited/encouraged candidates to run against Republican incumbents.
5. Mr. Raesemann has proven that he has no desire to participate in any WCRP events such as Executive Board training, Mix and Mingle, 2021 Reagan Dinner, the 2022 Just Desserts Event and recently the County Party Annual Picnic since his election in April 2020. (Article II, Section 2, Paragraph 1, WCRP Bylaws).
6. Mr. Raesemann seizes opportunities to put the Williamson County GOP and the Chairman in a false light with citizens of the county.

7. Mr. Raesemann supports Independents running in a partisan race. (Article II, Section 4 TN GOP bylaws)

8. Board Members and fellow Republicans are aware that Mr. Raesemann is actively working with a Non-Republican organization to undermine and weaken the County and State-level GOP. (Article 1 section 2). Also, he is sharing county Party board meetings and conversations with these individuals. We highly suspect Mr. Raesemann has been recording our board meetings without request.

On many occasions Mr. Raesemann has acted in a way that is unbecoming as a CEC and member of the WCRP.
